Rudbeckia hirta

- Late summer blooms
- It will spread, so plant it where it can expand
- 2-3 ft height

Care

- Plant it, water infrequently until established
- Cut back in late winter or early spring
- Forget about it!

Butterfly Milkweed

Asclepias tuberosa

- Summer blooms
- Looks best planted in groups
- 2-3 ft height
- Host to Monarch butterfly babies!

Care

- Plant it, water infrequently until established
- Cut back in late winter or early spring
- Forget about it!

Switch Grass

Panicum virgatum

- Tall ornamental grass
- Clumping habit
- 3-6 ft height depending on variety
- Looks great in groups and in winter!
- Look for varieties Northwind, Shenandoah, Heavy Metal

Care

- Plant it, water infrequently until established
- Cut back in late winter or early spring
- Forget about it!
